- 1. Title of Book
- 2. Total number of pages of the book
- 3. Protagonist: the person that is changed by the events of the book
 - a. Three examples that show how the Protagonist transforms through the Denouement with page numbers and quotes
- 4. Antagonist: the person that tries to stop the protagonist from reaching their goal; they aren't changed by the events in the book
 - a. Three examples that show how the Antagonist tries to influence or impede the Protagonist through the Climax with page numbers and quotes
- 5. Core of the Conflict:
 - a. Proof of what is at the heart of the battle between the protagonist and the antagonist with page numbers
- 6. Major Events that lead to Climax
 - a. 3 Major Events that align with the Core of the Conflict that lead to the Climax with page numbers and quotes

7. Climax:

- a. Final Event that aligns with Major Events and the Core of the Conflict between the Protagonist and the Antagonist with page numbers and quotes
- 8. Denouement or no Denouement:
 - a. Event that aligns with the Climax and resolves the Core of the Conflict between the Protagonist and the Antagonist OR
 - b. In modern novels, there may be no clear resolution. You need to show how this works with your book
- 9. 30 Vocabulary Words from the book with definitions that match the context as well as the page number where the word was found
