
Emotional Cycle of Deployment



The School Liaison Officer (SLO) is the central point of contact for school-related matters between NRNW Commands, military families, and local school systems. The SLO specializes in serving military students and families, and offers a wide spectrum of services to include:

Seven Core Functions of the SLO:

- 1. School transition services
- 2. Deployment Support
- 3. Special education system navigation
- 4. Command, school, community communications
- 5. Home school linkage and support
- 6. Partnerships in education
- 7. Post-secondary preparation

Eligibility for School Liaison Officer Services:

SLOs serve families of active duty, guard, reservists and civilian employees of all military branches.

- Resources on local schools
- Public, private, home school options
- Special needs district and community contacts
- Washington State core graduation requirements
