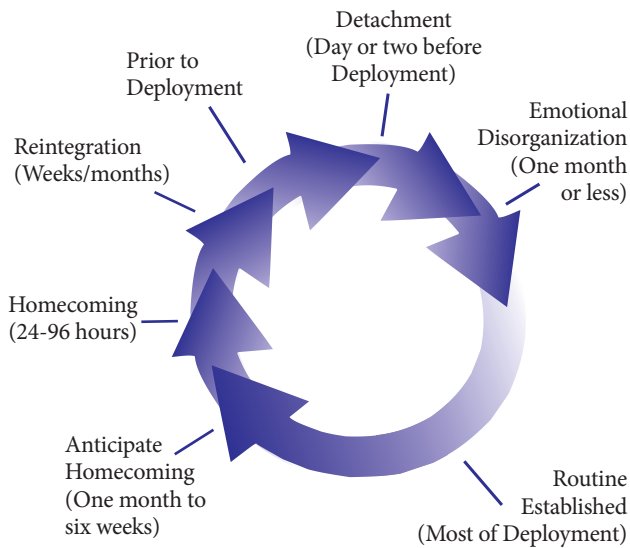


## Emotional Cycle of Deployment

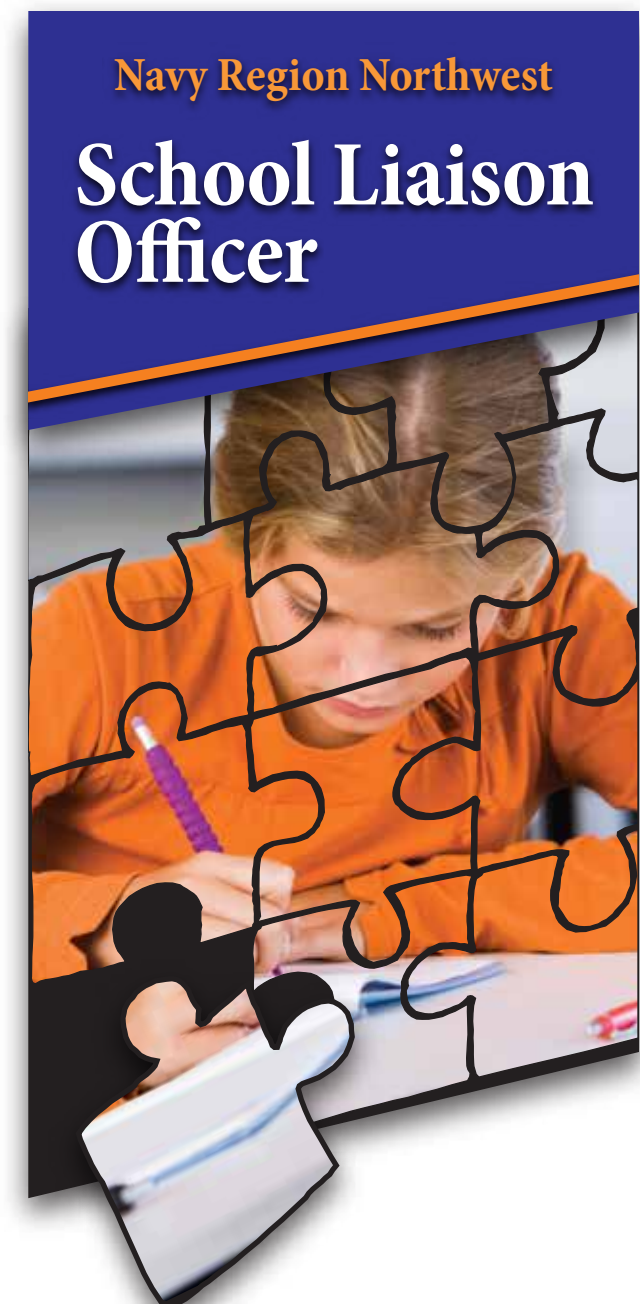

# K-12 Transition Checklist:

*The School Liaison Officer (SLO) is the central point of contact for school-related matters between NRNW Commands, military families, and local school systems. The SLO specializes in serving military students and families, and offers a wide spectrum of services to include:*

## Seven Core Functions of the SLO:

1. School transition services
2. Deployment Support
3. Special education system navigation
4. Command, school, community communications
5. Home school linkage and support
6. Partnerships in education
7. Post-secondary preparation

## Eligibility for School Liaison Officer Services:

SLOs serve families of active duty, guard, reservists and civilian employees of all military branches.

- Support for inbound/outbound school transfers
- Resources on local schools
- Public, private, home school options
- Special needs district and community contacts
- Washington State core graduation requirements
- Military and community resources

- IEP/504/gifted records

- Guardianship/custody papers
- Letters of recommendation
- Writing sample
- Proof of residency/military orders
