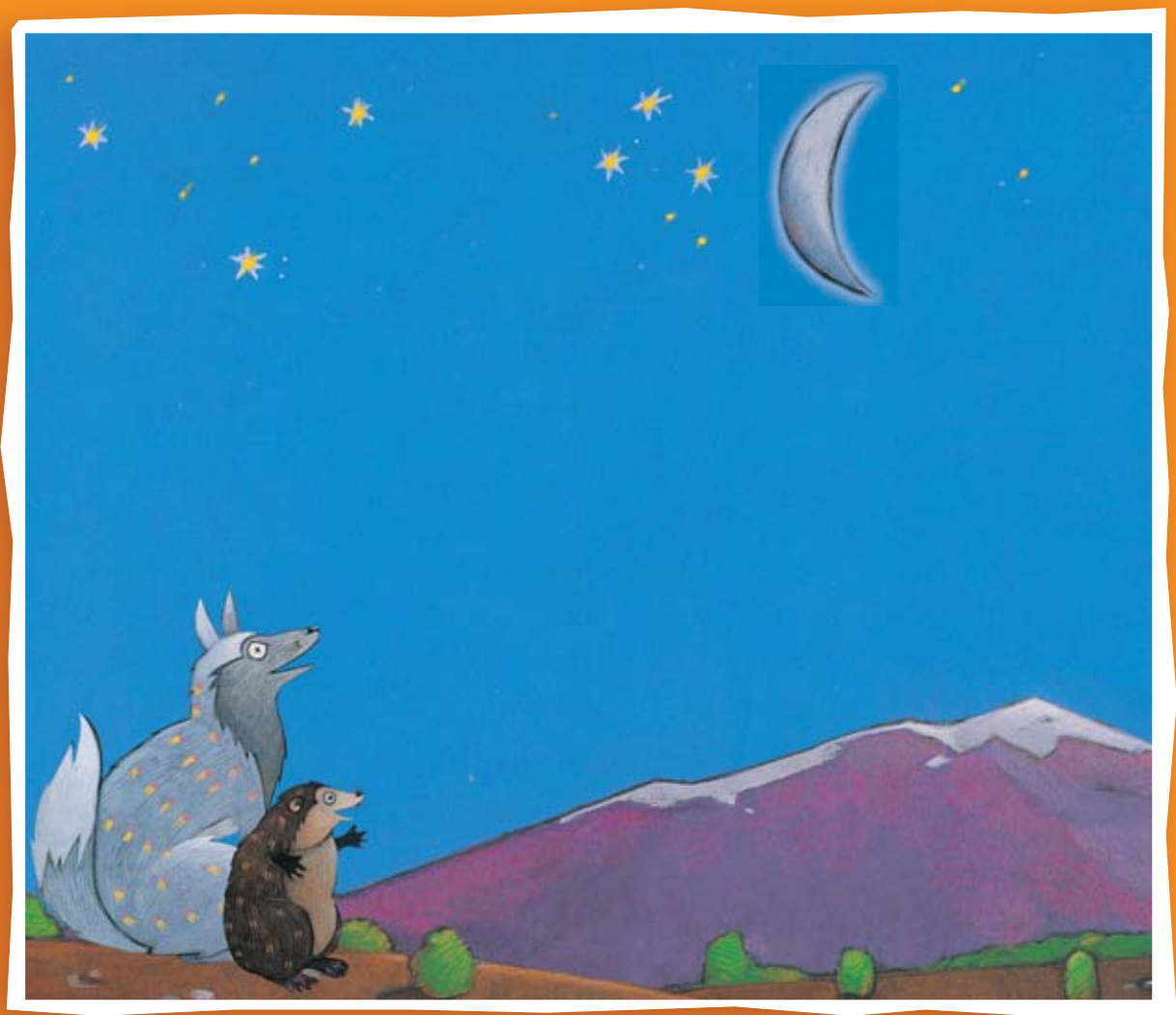

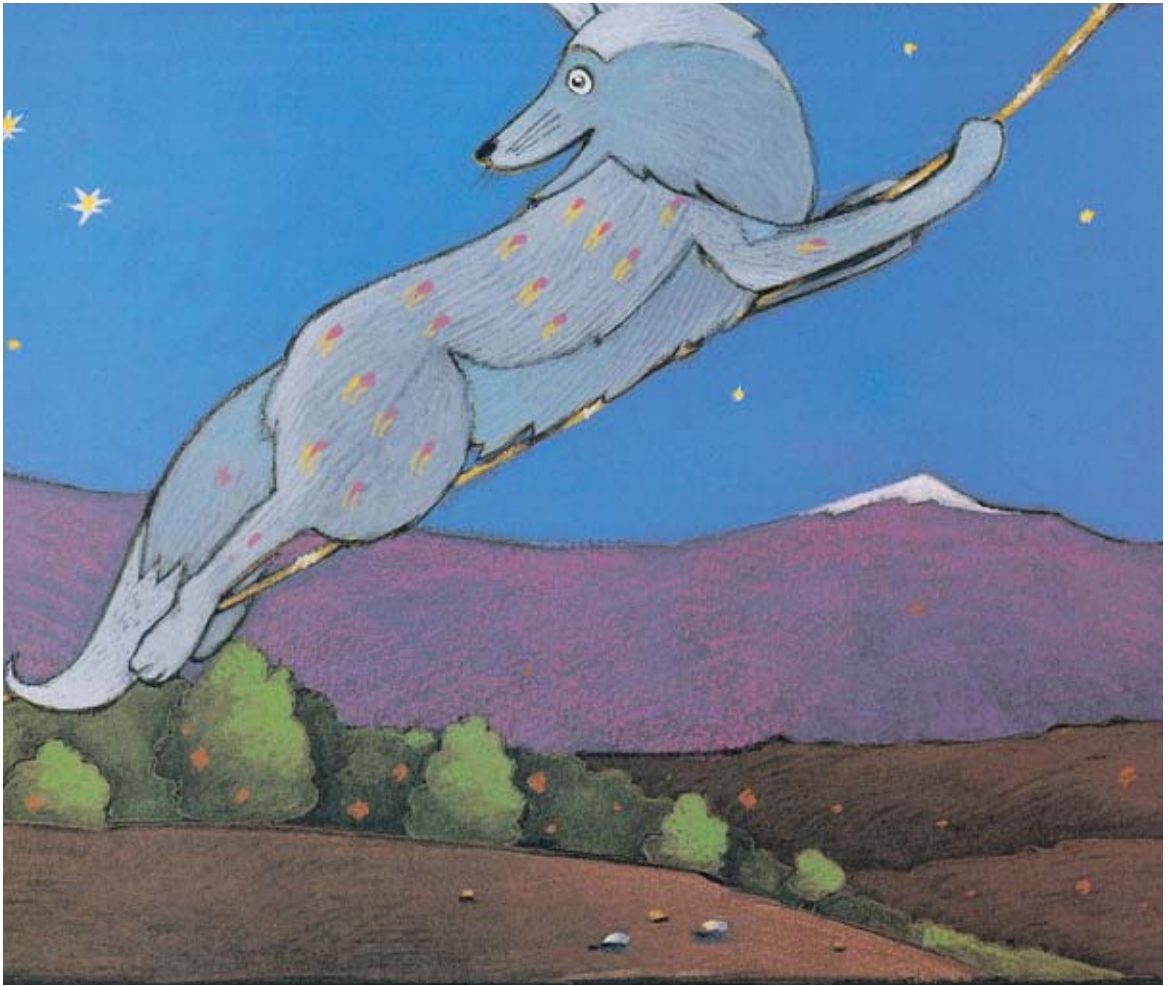
“Mole, look up,” said Fox. “I want to have a home up there.”



“Not me, Fox,” said Mole. “I do not like to go up.” But fox did not give up.



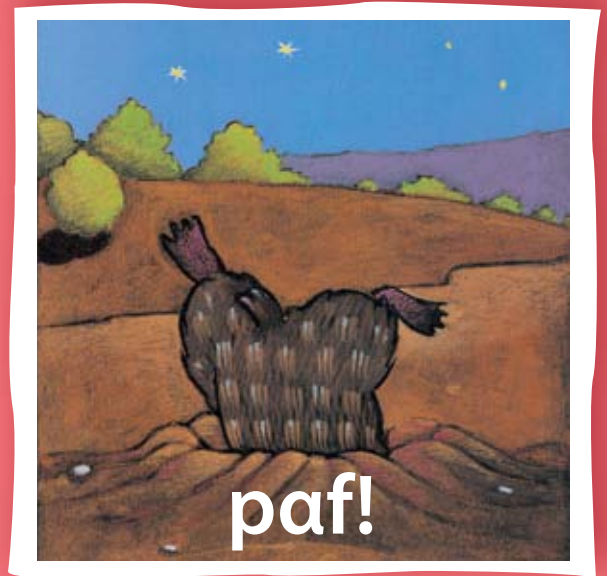
“Look, Mole,” said Fox.
