Dear Everett High School Parents,

As we come to the end of our first year of the Everett Public Schools 1:1 student computing experience we are taking stock of the impacts that we have seen in classroom instruction and student learning. While we celebrate what we accomplished in this first year, we believe that next year will see an even deeper integration of the laptops into the daily routine of staff and students.

We wanted to provide an overview of the laptop return process that will take place at the end of the year. After the last final, teachers will be collecting all the laptops. Over the summer months, the Learning and Information Technology Services staff will update the software and check for any issues to ensure the devices are running at their best for the fall. Students who are returning to EHS for the 2018-2019 school year will receive their same device back when they return to school.

The summer update process is critical to the ongoing health of your student’s computer. If updates and software patches are not applied, the computer will begin to malfunction and eventually become unusable. That is why it is critical that each student bring in their laptop at the end of the year to turn in so we can complete this update process. If your son or daughter will be leaving before the last day of the school year, have them contact the office to see where they can turn in their laptop before they leave. It could be different depending on the day. Even if something happens and they forget until the middle of summer, they can call 425.385.4200 and the Learning and Information Technology Services team will walk them through where to turn in their device.

These updates are so important that we have established a system of fines if the devices are not turned in for this refresh.
