IMPORTANT INFORMATION

ASB CARD/ID Card

ASB cards are required for participation in athletics and school activities. ID cards are free to all students. ID/ASB cards are needed to check out books, internet use, free/reduced lunches, and school functions. Replacement cards are \$5.00. All students must carry an ID card or an ASB card on them during regular school hours.

ATTENDANCE

Parents/guardians: You may excuse an absence by sending an email to ehsattendance@everettsd.org, calling our attendance line at 425-385-4405, sending a note with your student, or faxing a note to 425-385-4402. You must include student name, ID number, date and periods of absence, and reason for the absence. Phone calls and emails must be from the number/address that the school has on file. All absences must be excused within 30 days.

COMPUTER CHECK OUT

Issued laptops in the fall for use during the school year. Students are responsible for taking care of the device and reporting any issues to the library. Check in at the end of the year.

FREE/REDUCED LUNCH

Students need to fill out the form every September to qualify for Free and Reduced meals. The form may be picked up in the main office, counseling center, or the cashier in the cafeteria.

GRADES

Official grades are issued at Everett High School twice a school year and progress reports twice a year. Grades may be checked regularly online at http://www.everett.k12.wa.us/everett. Students must register first before they can access grades.

LIBRARY

The school library will be open from 6:30 am until 3:30 pm Monday through Thursday to allow students access to library services and homework support. Friday hours are 6:30 am until 12:50 pm, unless otherwise posted.

LOCKERS

Lockers are located in the "A" building. Locker assignment will take place starting the 2nd week of school.
