
# First Grade Reading Skills

#### Main Idea and Details

Main Idea: What is the story mostly about?

<u>Details:</u> Facts/evidence that support the main idea.



### Compare and Contrast

Finding similarities and differences between different things, books, characters, etc. and comparing them. A Venn Diagram is one way to organize this information.




### Making Predictions

Prediction: A guess made using text/picture clues.




## Cause and Effect

<u>Cause:</u> Why something happened. <u>Effect:</u> What happened as a result?




#### <u>Author's Purpose</u>

Authors write stories for many reasons. Was the author's purpose to persuade, inform, or entertain?



## Inferencing

Using what you have read to learn more than the author specifically states.



### Fact and Opinion

Fact: A true statement that can be proven. Opinion:

A Statement stating what someone thinks or feels.
