Key Terms:



- Cold War:
 - Rivalry between "Communism" and "Democracy". Both sides had huge arsenals of nuclear weapons.
 - Roughly 1945-1990
 - Called "Cold War" because no actual war was fought between the dominant countries (USA, UK, France, China, USSR).

- · Alliance:
 - Countries associating or joining together for mutual benefit or to achieve a common purpose.

- Political or Military Alliance:
 - Countries associating for joint defense.

- Economic Alliance:
 - Countries associating to increase trade or business connections.

· NATO:

- (North Atlantic Treaty Organization)
- Mutual defense treaty formed in 1949.
- Included many nations in western Europe, plus the USA and Canada.
- Also called "Western Bloc" nations.
- Still exists today. Currently 29 nations.

Cold War Military Alliances:

Warsaw Pact:

- Formed in 1955, in response to formation of NATO.
- Included the USSR, plus 7 other communist counties in Eastern Europe.
- Also called "Eastern Bloc" countries.
- Mostly under the control of the USSR.
