### Bottoms

**Pants** – Navy Blue or Khaki, Twill or Corduroy

**Shorts**- Navy Blue or Khaki,

Twill **Capris**-Navy Blue or

Khaki, Twill **Skort**- Navy Blue

or Khaki, Twill **Skirt**- Navy

Blue, Khaki

**Jumper**-Navy blue or Khaki, Twill

### Shirt

**Polo Shirt**- Navy blue or white polo, long or short sleeved

**Turtle Neck**- Navy blue or white, long sleeved turtleneck

### Warm Layer

**Sweatshirt**- Solid colored red, blue or white, v-neck or crew neck (no hooded items)

**Sweater**- Solid colored red, blue or white, cardigan, v-neck or crew neck

**Hawthorne Logo Sweatshirt**- School provided

**Winter Coats/ Jackets**- May be worn to school and while outside
