Dear Jefferson families.

On Monday, March 15, we will be moving to <u>stage 4B learning model status</u>, welcoming back some students in Grades 4-5.

I'm writing with more information on how teaching and learning will look moving forward for your student, whom you indicated you would like to remain fully remote.

We understand that consistency is important, and we tried to keep as many students with their current teachers as possible. There were some changes in teacher assignments required to accommodate family and staff needs and preferences. We will work hard to provide a smooth transition as students experience new teachers and classmates, and teachers will be in touch with you soon to prepare.

Your child's remote schedule will remain very similar to what you've experienced so far this year:

- Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, Friday: Remote instruction
- Wednesday: 45 minutes of synchronous check-in and instruction at the beginning
 of the day, with the remainder of day asynchronous (teacher-directed
 independent learning activities). Offering additional synchronous instruction on
 Wednesdays is at the teacher's discretion.

We truly appreciate your flexibility and understanding as we work to provide the best educational experience possible while protecting everyone's health and safety during this challenging time.
