



School-Based Health Center (SBHC) FAQs

1. Where is it?

The SBHC is on the Everett High School campus in the science building, room S101.

2. What period can I go to it?

We are open the entire school day. You can fill out the appointment request form <u>here</u> or stop by during your passing period or lunchtime to chat with us and set up an appointment.

3. How do I get out of class?

We will send you passes that you can show your teachers to get out of class for an appointment.

4. What permission do I need from my parents?

Parents and guardians can fill out the registration and consent form <u>here</u>. School-based health centers follow all Washington State <u>minor consent laws</u>, and parents and guardians are included in care whenever it is safe and possible.

5. Do I check in at the office or go straight there?

When you get your pass for your appointment, you can go straight to the SBHC. After your appointment, you will return to the office to have your attendance addressed and then be sent back to class.

6. Can my siblings or friends from other schools come here too?

You need to be a student at Everett High School to be seen at this SBHC.

7. How is this clinic different from the school nurse?

The SBHC offers medical, dental, and behavioral health services in addition to what the school nurse offers. In short, if you get injured or sick at school, you still see the school nurse. If needed, she will help you make an appointment at the SBHC.

8. What is the cost of the services?

There is no out-of-pocket cost for students accessing services at the school-based health center. Health insurance, if available, will be billed for eligible services, but you will not receive a bill.

9. Are the services confidential?

Yes, the services are confidential from school staff, other students, and in some cases (consistent with Washington State Law) from parents.

10. What are the hours?
