SCHOLARSHIP 2022 APPLICATION FORM

SOROPTIMIST INTERNATIONAL OF EVERETT is sponsoring a scholarship in the amount of \$3,000 to be given to a 2022 high school graduate of a school within the boundaries of the Everett School District.

Competition is open to all students who will graduate from high school at the end of the current school year and will enroll in a college, university, vocational school or advanced training as a full-time student during the 2022-2023 academic year. The Permanent Scholarship Committee of Soroptimist International of Everett will select and announce the winner this spring.

The criteria for selection include goals, service, leadership in school and community and financial need.

The recipient of this scholarship may attend a fully accredited institution of his/her choice. The scholarship money will be deposited in the financial aid office at that institution to be used for educational expenses.

The application must be forwarded to Soroptimist by the high school scholarship counselor or Mr. Dahlke, Career Specialist, in JHS Career Center.

The application is due by March 4, 2022.

The scholarship winner will be notified on or before April 1, 2022.

The award may be presented at the May 18, 2022 Soroptimist Program Meeting depending on the status of COVID 19.
