Now Hiring for Seasonal Utility Worker Positions \$20.00 - \$23.00/hr. (depending on experience)

Mukilteo Water and Wastewater District is accepting applications to fill multiple full-time seasonal utility worker positions. These positions are temporary and will end at or before 5 months, depending on the selected candidate's schedule.

The positions, under the direction of the department supervisor, perform a variety of manual labor tasks; assisting with routine maintenance of the District owned facilities, grounds, vehicles, and any other tasks assigned. This position uses a variety of hand/power-operated tools and equipment.

Duties and Responsibilities: The following is a list of some of the duties and responsibilities for this position.

- Performs general maintenance of wastewater treatment plant grounds including mowing, weeding, pressure washing, painting, janitorial, scrubbing, basic carpentry and mechanical repairs, and other duties as assigned.
- Maintain, clean, and paint fire hydrants, blow-offs, valve markers, and meter boxes.
- Operate small power tools required to complete the maintenance of water and wastewater systems.
- Maintain a safe work environment including utilizing appropriate safety devices and equipment.
- Other related duties as assigned.

Work environment: Duties are primarily performed outdoors requiring physical effort to perform manual labor, lifting in excess of 50 pounds is required.

Requirements: Applicants must have a valid Washington State driver's license and a good driving record. Driving record abstracts are required prior to the first day of employment.
