



A Day Camp for Children with Special Needs

Camp Prov is a fantastic opportunity to come make a difference in kids' lives over the summer. Held at Forest Park every year, hundreds of kids come to spend a week doing activities and hanging out with their buddy (that's you!).

To join this summer, you'll need to be in at least 8th grade (or turn 14 by August 31st) and apply during open applications. When volunteering at Camp Prov, you will be required to go to at least 1 full week, either morning, afternoon or both sessions.

All **new volunteers** will need to attend an orientation with their parent or guardian. This is a vital part of the process where you will learn more about Camp Prov, the requirements and expectations during camp and be able to ask questions directly with Volunteer Services and the Camp Prov Director. If you are a **returning volunteer** from last year, you do not need to attend an orientation, but will receive information on completing a Health Screening.
