ABOUT THE SCHOLARSHIP

Applications are open to graduating high school seniors who have volunteered at least 75 hours in a field involving the health and/or welfare of children. Each scholarship recipient will be awarded a \$3,000 college scholarship to be used within the first school year following high school graduation.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

Graduating seniors must have participated in volunteer activities over a one-year period from March 29, 2025 to March 31, 2026 with a minimum of 75 hours.

Volunteer activities must involve the health and/or welfare of children.

Special consideration will be given to a recipient who is pursuing a degree that encompasses the health and/or welfare of children.

Financial need will be considered when awarding these scholarships.

APPLICATION PROCESS

* At least two letters of recommendation from persons other than a relative. Letters need to be requested at least two weeks before the application is due.

* One evaluation letter from the applicant's volunteer/community service advisor

* Official academic transcripts

* Personal resume

Applications are open to graduating high school seniors who have volunteered at least 75 hours within the Providence organization or in other activities that involve the health and/or welfare of children. Special consideration will be given to an applicant who is pursuing a degree that promotes the health care needs of children. Financial need will be considered when awarding these scholarships. **Each scholarship will be in the amount of \$3,000.** All scholarships must be used within the first year following high school graduation.

Four of the PGCA scholarships are dedicated to the memory of volunteers Dorothy Bogdanovich, Eileen Denhoff, Jeannette Pearson, and Mary Jane Miller, who helped shape PGCA into the excellent association it is today. These women worked tirelessly over many years to contribute to and promote the health care needs of children in the Northwest region of Washington State. We are honored to present these scholarships in their names.

All applications must include:

1. At least two letters of recommendation from persons other than a relative. Letters should be requested at least two weeks before the application is due.
2. Evaluation letter from the applicant's volunteer/community service advisor
3. Official academic transcripts
4. Personal resume

All applications must be computer generated in a PDF or Word Document with the subject line titled "PGCA Scholarship Application". All parts of the application must be submitted together.

Personal Goals: What are your career goals, and what is your action plan to achieve these goals?

Financial need: Free or reduced lunch, for example, is one of the considerations for a scholarship. If you or your immediate family has encountered financial hardships, include how that is affecting your future educational plans. (100 words or less).
