TIPS Internships: More Than Just a Summer Job!

What is Teens In Public Service? Teens In Public Service (TIPS) provides paid public service internships to teenagers, working in non-profit organizations throughout the Greater Puget Sound region and the surrounding region for 6 - 8 weeks during the summer.

Why is TIPS a good choice for summer employment?

- TIPS is a rewarding summer job. You can earn a paycheck while giving back to your community.
- TIPS gives teens an inside look into how community-based services are carried out by nonprofits.
- TIPS internship participation can help you discover your career interests and goals and is a valuable item on a resume or college application.

What can I expect to get out of a TIPS internship?

- Gain exposure to professional work environments in fields such as social and human services, education, youth development, and program management.
- Learn transferrable work and leadership skills which can be applied to future jobs or academics.
- Develop connections at your nonprofit and a deeper understanding of you can help meet the needs of your community.
- Earn over \$3000 during the 6-8 week internship experience

You should apply to be a TIPS intern if you...

- Are aged 15-19, or will be 15 by May 22, 2024, and are enrolled in high school (graduating class years 2024, 2025, 2026, or 2027)
- Can commit to a part-time work schedule for 6-8 weeks during the summer months of June-August
- Are passionate about community, public service, and social justice
- Have a desire to grow your leadership capabilities and practical work skills

You MUST also attend 3 mandatory events:

- **May 22nd**, Intern Orientation (evening)
- **July 20th**, Leadership Day (full day)
- **August 17th** Celebration of Service (morning)
