

Kinder & 1st Grade:

This Month Kinder and 1st Grade Students will be working on a special Glow Show project, creating glowing fish and glowing Sea Turtles for the 3rd Annual Glow Show this Spring.



2nd & 3rd Grade:

Moving on to the Element of Color, 2nd and 3rd Graders will be creating Painted Color Wheel Lions. They will be reviewing primary and Secondary Colors.
