What's Going on in the Art Room?

Kinders - We are wrapping up learning about the first Element of Art - Line. Kinders worked hard to create a fun Line Sculpture, as well as a Painted Line Design. In November we will move on to the second Element of Art - Shapes!

1st and 2nd Grade Students completed their 4 Seasons of Color Trees by using Oil Pastels and creating Scratch Art. They then moved on to their next project called "My Identity Letter". They learned how to draw a bubble letter for the first letter of their first name, and then sketched at least 8 items that represent who they are. Both projects focus on the Art Medium of Drawing.

3rd and 4th Grade Students have completed their "Moving Through Emotions" art project using Oil Pastels and Sharpie. They have now moved on to learning about and creating their own Curio Cabinets. Both projects have focused on the Art Medium of Drawing.

5th Grade (Principles of Design-CONTRAST) Students completed their "Moodscapes", drawing 2 opposite emotions, and representing those emotions using the first Principal of Design - Pattern, as well as Lines, Shapes, Symbols, and Warm and Cool Colors. Students have now moved on to the second Principal of Design - Contrast, and will be creating a City Skyline using oil pastels and scratch art.
