- 1. Go to district website. www.everettsd.org
- 2. Go to the "Grades and more" page
- 3. Select Pearson: on bottom right side list.
- 4. You might have to select



- 5. You will then be prompted to log in.
- 6. Use your student number and the password you use to log into computers at school.

You should now be able to navigate through the text, videos, examples, and other resources easily!

When "at home"-
