Dear Cascade Students and Parents,

Welcome! We are excited to have you join us at the School of Pride for the 2018-19 school year.

If you have received this letter and have moved, or are not planning to attend Cascade please notify us of this fact as soon as possible. Go to our website at www.everett.k12.wa.us/cascade and click on “Not Returning to Cascade High School in 2018-19” on the main page, within the “Quicklinks.”

First Day of School: School will begin the Wednesday after Labor Day, September 5, 2018. We invite all students to attend our Schedule Pick-Up and Purchasing Days to receive their tentative schedule and fix any errors before school starts. **Information is on the back of this letter.** If you cannot attend these days, your schedule will be available to you on the first day of school. On the first day of school, all students will go directly to their first period class. School bus routes will be available on the district website in August before school begins.

School Supplies: On the first day of school, students should bring a 3-ring binder, notebook paper, pen and pencil. Individual teachers will share additional supplies needed for their class.

1:1 Device Roll Out: This fall, all students will be provided a personal device for classroom use and homework. On Tuesday, September 11, all students who have a parent/guardian signed agreement (provided after the first day of school) will be able to check out their personal device for the year.

Picture Day/Arena Day: Picture day will be Thursday, September 13. Picture information will be distributed after the beginning of school. Students will also be able to purchase ASB Cards and Yearbooks on this day.

Fall Sports: Athletic forms are now available on-line at rankonesport.com Practice for Football begins on Wednesday, August 15. Practice and tryouts for all other sports (Volleyball, Cross Country, Girls Soccer, Girls Swim, and Boys Tennis) begin on Monday, August 20. All athletes must submit their paperwork on-line **before** practices/tryouts begin. Athletes are responsible for...

1. Submitting the **three** on-line registration forms (Informed Consent, Emergency Form, Eligibility Questionnaire)
2. Current physical exam on file in the school Athletics office (Physical cannot expire during a season)
3. Showing proof of an ASB card purchase for the current (2018-19) school year
4. Clearing all obligations (both ASB and library) on file - a separate check for obligations is required
5. Clearance wristband must be picked up before 1st day of sport.

The Athletics Office will be open beginning **Monday, August 13**. Mrs. Covert’s Office Hours will be 7:30 am to 11:30 am and 12:30 pm to 3 pm.
