Counseling and Schedules

Schedules were released Monday, August 31st at 8 am. They can be accessed on the Home Access Center (HAC) link <u>here</u>. Requests for schedule changes can be made **if** you are missing a class, **if** you are a senior who is missing a course for graduation, or **if** you don't have the prerequisite for a class on your schedule. Requests for schedule changes must be done **online only** by clicking <u>here</u>. Please do not email the counselors with requests--this form gets to them much quicker, we promise!

School Structure and Bell Schedule

We are beginning the year in 100% distance learning mode. The schedule** for fall distance learning days is <u>here</u>. Your **first day of school** will be September 9th, and you begin **by logging in to Canvas** through our website at the beginning of each period. **Important note: for the first three days of school (September 9th, 10th and 11th), we will begin on a **2.5 hour reduced** <u>schedule</u> to allow parents and students time to meet and conference with their teachers. You **will receive the specific schedule** from the school next week about where to go during these times.

Technology

Each EHS student needs a device to access content. We realize some of you have some awesome laptops and devices at home, but they won't work with your classes.
