**width of table will vary based on your logo width

Process steps

1. Organize your files: **BEFORE** you begin create a folder named period2-LastName-Table, inside this folder create:
 1. Save all images in the images folder - you will lose points if you do not this is an important skill!
 2. Save all html files in the table folder
2. Create your Home Page: This page takes the longest because all other pages are derived from it. PAY ATTENTION!
 1. Add your basic tags to the web page: `<html><head><title></title></head><body></body></html>`
 2. Be sure to add the following title: Your Name Tables Page
 3. Save your page as table.html
 4. Create a table tag in the body of your table.html page
 5. Add a Table Row tag with one TD that has a colspan of 3. Add the text: My logo collection between the tags
 6. Add a Table Row tag with 3 td tags, the middle td tag will have a rowspan attribute equal to 2. Add your logos in them
 1. `<td>  </td>`
 7. Add a Table Row tag with two TD tags, place your two remaining logos inside these td tags.
 8. Save your tables.html page and test in the browser
 9. Turn in your tables folder to the inbox
