- Today's Black History event is the signing of the 15th
- Amendment to the Constitution of the United States of America. The 15th Amendment reads, "The right of citizens of the United States to vote shall not be denied or abridged by the United States or by any State on account of race, color, or previous condition of servitude." This amendment is important to Black History for the reason that it allowed for African American men to vote. This amendment was signed on this day, February 3rd, in 1870.
