Starting in **January**, your student's Health class will address topics in sexual health education. Consistent with <u>district policy 2123</u>, content will address AIDS and sex education, including information about human anatomy, reproduction and related topics. AIDS prevention education will be limited to the discussion of the lifethreatening dangers of the disease, its spread and prevention.

The district's adopted curriculum, *Get Real: Comprehensive Sex Education That Works*, will be used for instruction. The following topics will be addressed, dependent on grade level:
