Registration Information for Full Credit Classes

STUDENTS CURRENTLY ATTENDING EVERETT PUBLIC SCHOOLS

Registration for tuition-based classes, both online and at Cascade HS, can be made on the Everett Public Schools website: www.everettsd.org/summerschool. Registration is available March 15th.

You must have a valid email account prior to registering for classes.

Tuition Payment is Required at Time of Registration

All students who register for a class are required to pay at the time of registration. Payments can be made either online with a credit card, or by cash or check (made payable to Everett Public Schools) through your high school treasurer.

Tuition Assistance (For Everett Public Schools Students Only)

Information about **LIMITED** tuition assistance is available through your high school success coordinator or counselor. Priority will be given to students who are credit deficient and have signed up for free or reduced lunch prior to May 1, 2019.

Tuition for in-district students is \$325.00 for each 0.5 credit class (one semester).

Final registration deadline: June 21ST, 2019.

After June 21st you will be put on a wait list.

STUDENTS WHO DO NOT ATTEND EVERETT PUBLIC SCHOOLS

Students living within the Everett Public Schools district boundary who **do not** attend Everett Public Schools OR students who are living outside the Everett Public Schools district who wish to attend summer school <u>must</u> contact the summer school office at 425-385-5170 or <u>sschool@everettsd.org</u> for registration information prior to purchasing classes.

Tuition Payment is Required Prior to Beginning Class

All students who register for a class are required to pay in full prior to the start of summer school. Payment instructions will be provided once you have completed registration.

Tuition for Non-Everett Public Schools students in good standing at their regular school is \$425.00 per 0.5 credit class (one semester).

Final registration deadline: June 21ST, 2019.

After June 21st you will be put on a wait list.

For **ALL** students in a class that is cancelled due to low enrollment or who withdraw from a course **prior to** July 5th, 2019 you will receive a full refund.

Students may take only one online class (one semester) at a time during the summer. With focused effort it is possible to take both semesters of a course, one semester at a time, during the six weeks of summer school. PE 1 is the only class that can be taken concurrently with another class.

To be eligible to enroll in a second summer school online class, you must earn a passing grade in the first class prior to Friday, July 19th. This allows time to complete the second course before the end of the summer semester on August 9th.

Tuition for the second course is due at the time you enroll in the second class. The fee for a second class will be the same rate paid for the first class during initial enrollment.
