

## What is new in Pearson math products?

- **NEW URL for district log in to Pearson Products for teachers and students with classes in eSchool – using Pearson’s EasyBridge**
- **Logging in to a district Windows computer automatically logs you in to Pearson**
  - o Chromebooks still require using a user name and password
- **LOG IN to New URL on Chromebook and outside of district – with district network ID and password**
- **Nightly process updates your class roster(s)**
  - o **Each semester you assign product to your class – no managing of students required.**

\*Specialists and other staff who do not have classes – you will log in using current credentials directly to SuccessNet. Do NOT use new link or EasyBridge Plus navigation.

## Q: How to get to New Log in page?

A: Different routes to same place

1. In Internet Explorer – the shortcut to Pearson has been updated to link to [Pearson EasyBridge](#)
2. Chrome browser shortcuts and all personal favorites and desktop shortcuts will need to be manually updated
3. Grades&More site has added a [Curriculum and Instruction Tools](#) page with a linked icon
4. EPS Google Apps – Shortcuts have been updated to Pearson
5. Go to SuccessNet directly but select EasyBridge Plus – type in Everett for school district search, and then select EVERETT SCHOOL DISTRICT 2 – on Chromebook or non-district computer – use network user name and password to log in.

## Q: How do I set up my classes to start each semester?

A: At the beginning of each semester you will Assign Product

1. Log in to Pearson EasyBridge
2. Navigate to a class (Elementary schools may want to use Homeroom or Math)
3. Select Assign Product
4. Find the right product on Pearson Product list
5. Check all boxes that apply to the course and scroll to bottom – make certain to hit SAVE
6. You can select the product from EasyBridge or navigate using PearsonSuccessNet link.

## Q: How do my students access Pearson?

A: Students will use the same route teachers use to access Pearson products.

1. Teachers should confirm in SuccessNet class view that they see their courses, then students can log in.
2. In Internet Explorer – the shortcut to Pearson has been updated to link to [Pearson EasyBridge](#)
3. Chrome browser shortcuts and all personal favorites and desktop shortcuts will need to be manually updated
4. Grades&More site has added a [Curriculum and Instruction Tools](#) page with a linked icon
5. EPS Google Apps – Shortcuts have been updated to Pearson

- Go to SuccessNet directly but select EasyBridge Plus – type in Everett for school district search, and then select EVERETT SCHOOL DISTRICT 2 – on Chromebook or non-district computer – use network user name and password to log in.

## New link for navigation to EasyBridge is required to access products

- Working on teacher, lab or classroom computers – (any district computer that is not a Chromebook) - logging on the computer will automatically log you into Pearson\*
  - o Just click the link – and you are logged in
  - o Students and teachers are automatically signed in to Pearson – no password required
- Chromebooks or personal devices – students or teachers will need to still log in through [Pearson EasyBridge](#)
  - o User name and password are the same as your network log in (the way you log into computer)

\*All other users – who are not scheduled with students in a class will log directly in to Pearson SuccessNet using their old log in credentials. Do NOT use new link or EasyBridge Plus navigation.

If you have classes in eSchool – you will see Classes & Products

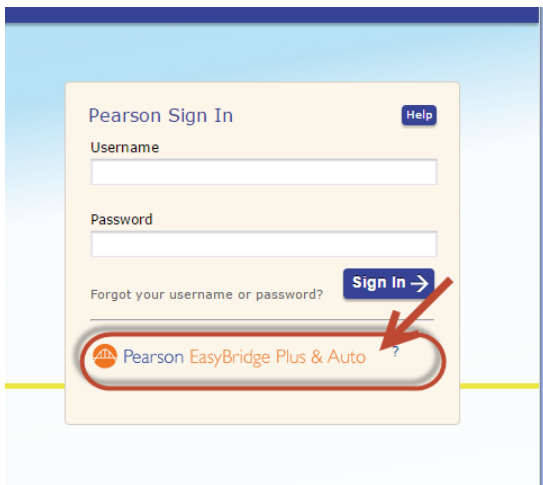

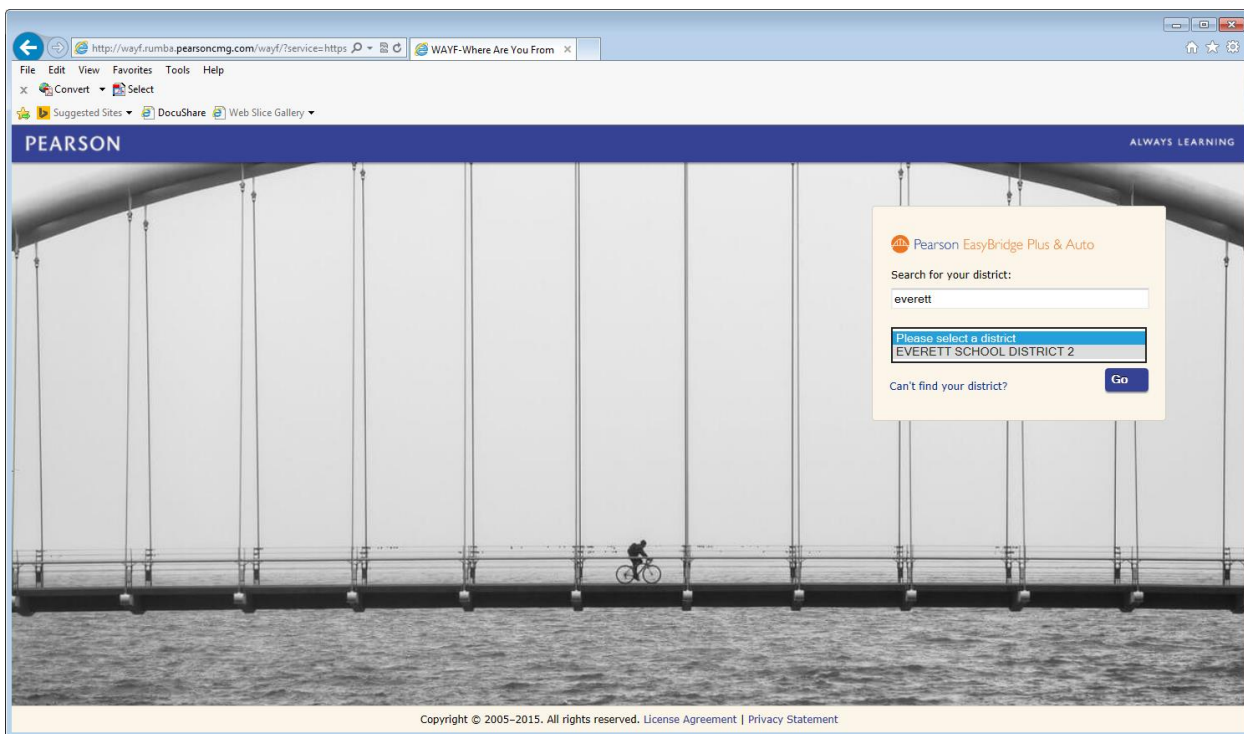
