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In the art room we've been drawing, cutting, and gluing. Students created art projects to review **line**, **shape**, and **color**. Using Crayola washable markers, plastic, and water students learned to transfer color. Did you hear about their fall leaves decorating the school halls? Clay is our next art medium to explore!

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The Great Weave was our first painting inspiration. We worked on using different **lines** to show movement on paper. Our next art unit is on **color!** Students will be using 3 primary colors, mixing tempera paint, to create their own full color wheel with 12 colors. Ask your 3rd or 4th grader to name the primary, secondary, and tertiary colors.

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Smile! Students created stunning self-portraits using their photos. With watercolors they painted striking backgrounds. Everyone agreed the final product was a masterpiece.

Our next unit is on collage animals. **Collage** comes from the French world *coller*, which means to glue.
