Be honest with yourself, there are no right or wrong answers.

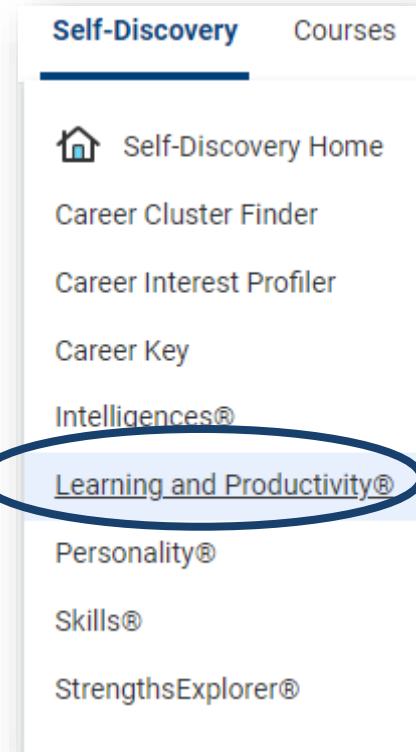

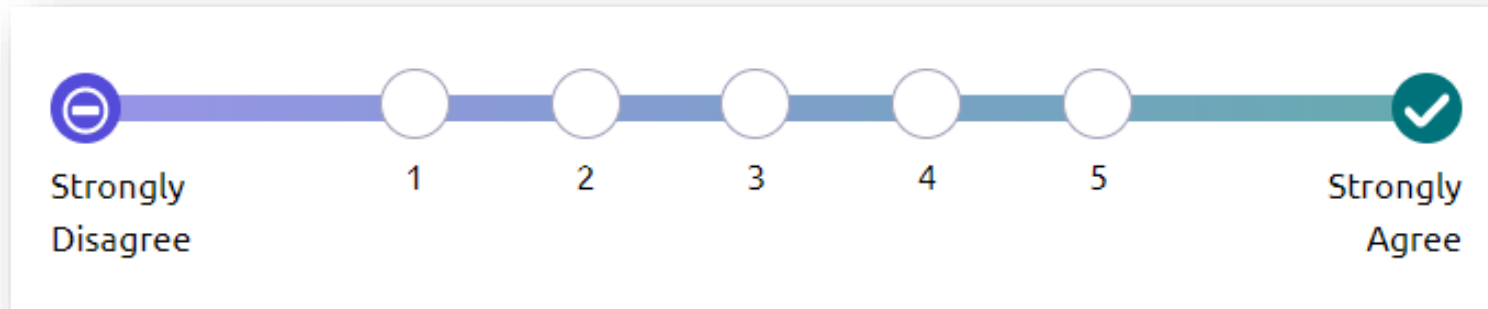

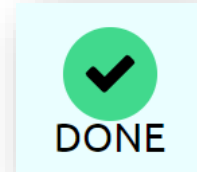

After rating your preferences on the statements, you will get your personalized report.

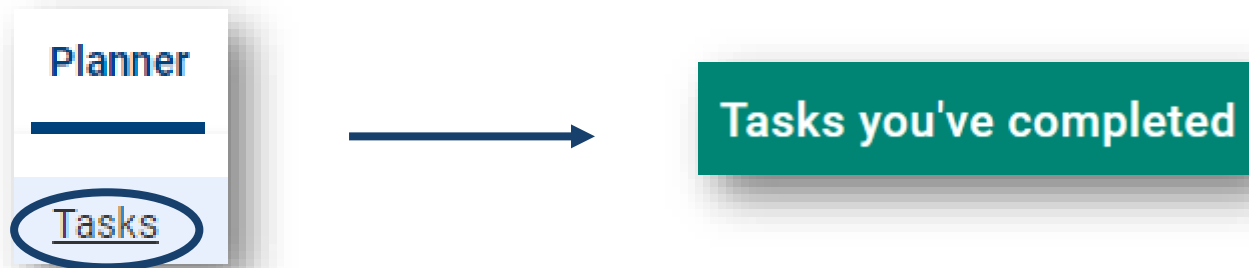
Your preferences are grouped into the categories of **sensory**, **environmental**, and **mindset**.

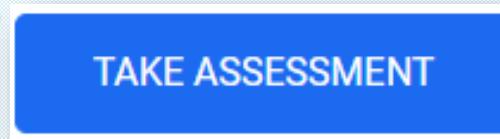

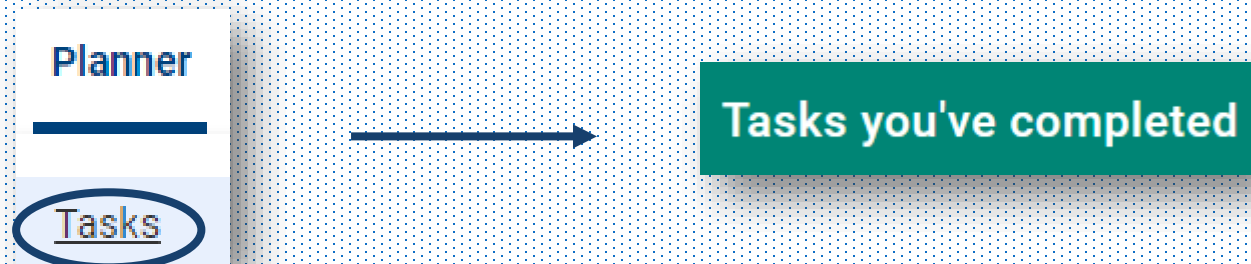

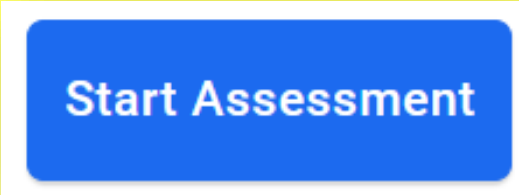


The assessment measures your creativity, conscientiousness, critical thinking, leadership and social-emotional skills.

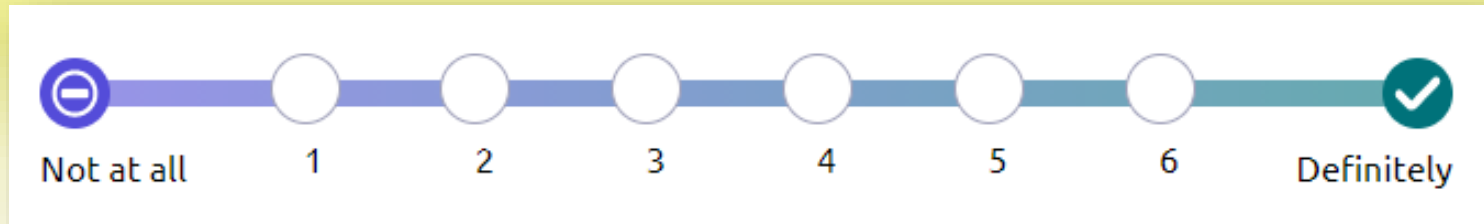
Begin the Skills Assessment

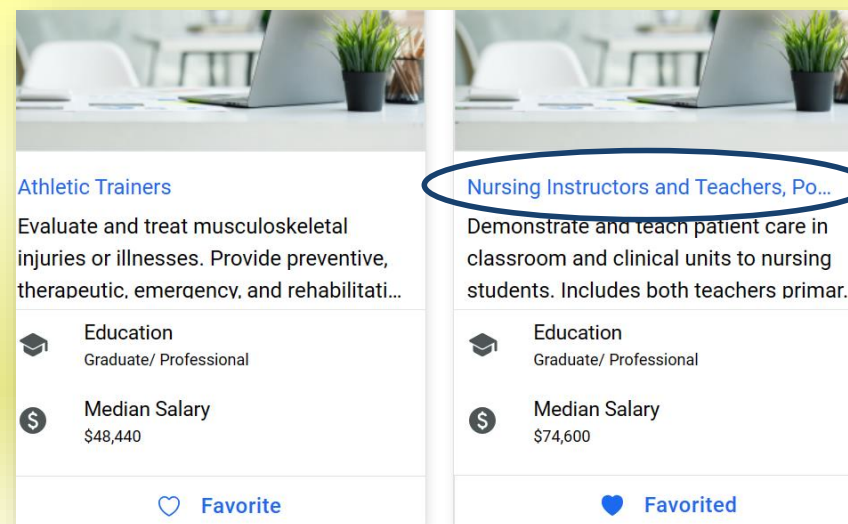

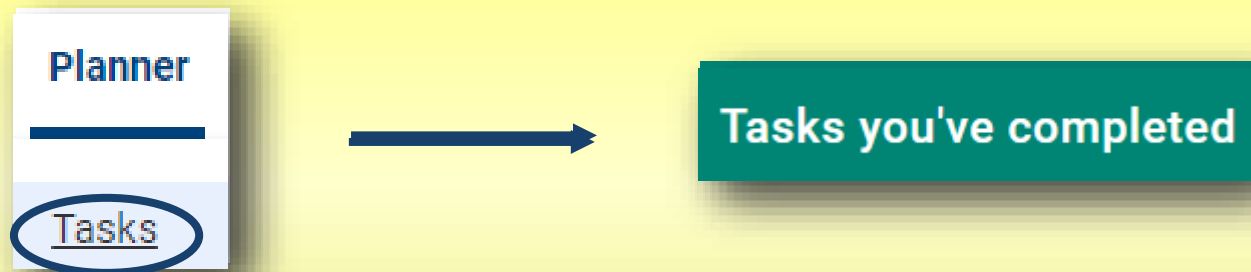

Things to be aware of before starting

If students took AP Research with Mrs. Carlson last year, this survey is blank and not the filled out one. Last year's brag sheet is inactive but Mrs. Pewitt has all the data so if you would like to copy/paste the data into this year's survey for teachers/counselors to see, email SPewitt@everettsd.org and she will send you that information.

If the students try to complete the whole brag sheet, it will take too long and Naviance will time out. If they don't save frequently, it will erase it.
