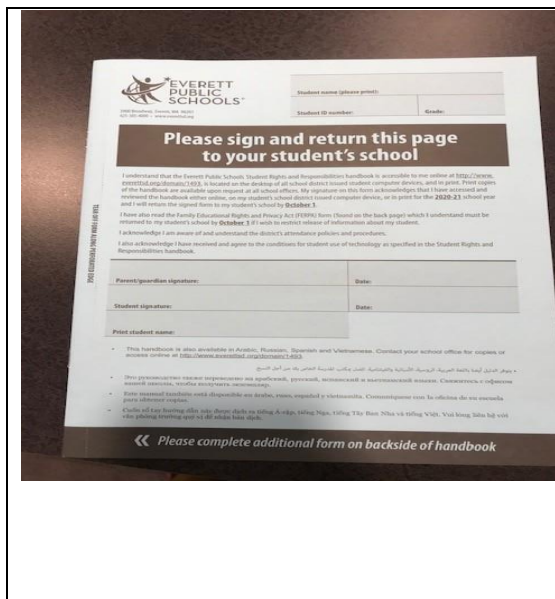

Let's Connect Meeting is a Family & Community Engagement meeting to engage in conversations with our community about students returning to the classroom for hybrid learning.

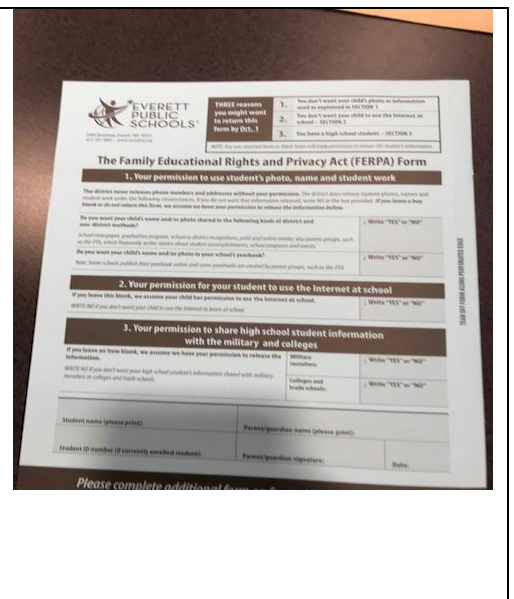

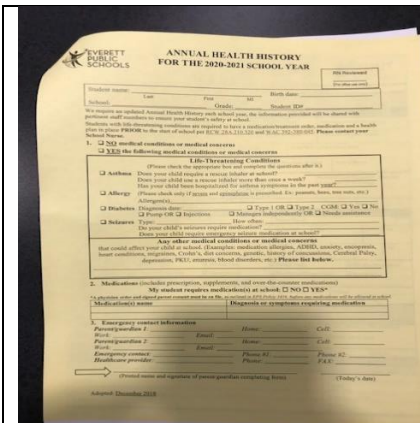


Student Rights & Responsibilities – Blue Sheets
