## Principal's Message

It's hard to believe that Spring Break starts next week. There is new excitement in the air as we plan to begin our hybrid learning model. I know you have received surveys and updates about the shift in model and that you still have many questions. Please note that there are still significant details concerning the return that will be finalized and then communicated in the coming days. I will make sure that updates are shared as they become available. I want to take a moment to remind you to please check our website, follow us on social media, and make sure you are not blocking our automatic phone messages, as those are the primary forms of communication.

In the last week we have been working with families and gathering survey results to identify the students who will be coming back for in-person instruction and those who will continue working remotely. I am amazed at the number of responses that have been collected, and that has allowed us to be even more intentional in our planning. I am aware that many families have questions regarding the schedule, safety precautions, attestation, transition, transportation, meals, after-school activities, open-campus lunch, parking, and much more. Currently I am focusing on the number of students who will be returning and making sure we have sufficient space based on the capacity number for the classrooms. Once the schedule is identified, communication will be going out to all families immediately. Please note that communication that is directly related to those coming back for in-person will be sent to that group only. Items that involve the whole school body will be sent out to both those at school for in-person instruction and those who will continue working remotely.

I want to thank all my families again for the support they have provided their students during this exceptionally challenging year. I truly look forward to the possibilities of the next couple of months as we look to finish the year strong.

counseling team set Registration Advisory meetings with *each* JHS student to discuss their high school and post-high school goals. Our students learned how to find their transcripts in HAC and review their credits to know what requirements they still needed to complete to earn their high school diploma.

New for fall 2021 is the dual-language Spanish immersion program at Emerson Elementary School. Families with children entering kindergarten will have the option to choose the dual-language strand. This program gives elementary

students an opportunity to complete the Everett Public Schools curriculum in a nontraditional and exciting way by immersing them in Spanish language and culture from kindergarten through twelfth grade. Students in the program will become proficient in both Spanish and English while learning the same curriculum content as their peers outside the program.



Priority will be given to students within the Emerson Elementary School attendance area. If a high number of students apply, a lottery will be conducted to select students. If the class is not filled from those in the Emerson attendance area, an additional lottery from beyond the school attendance area will be conducted.

No action is required on your part. You should have already received a welcome email from Peachjar that includes a username and password. This is provided so you can manage your account and flyer delivery preferences. Don't worry if you've forgotten your password—you can reset it at any time.
