## **Class Description**

Welcome to Accelerated 6th Grade Math (or 6/7 Compacted Math). This class is designed to cover all 6th grade math standards as well as some 7th grade math standards to prepare students for future accelerated math classes. Accelerated math is designed for students who are ready for more challenging and rigorous concepts with extension and enrichment opportunities and aiming for deeper understanding. Students are expected to come to class prepared, ready to learn, and keep up with daily activities and assignments. Daily class time consists of direct instruction, Cool Down quizzes, and practice problems. Daily assignments that are not completed during class-time will be completed as homework.

### **Summative Assessments:**

All summative assessments will be graded on a 4-point scale:

**Level 4: Exceeding Standards**  
**Level 3: Meeting/At Standards**  
**Level 2: Approaching Standards**  
**Level 1: Below Standards**

### **Assessment Retakes:**

Students who scored at level 1 or 2 will have the opportunity to retake each assessment 1 time to earn up to level 3 (meeting/at standards). Retake must be completed no later than 2 weeks after students receive graded assessments.

### **Assessment Retake Policy:**

In order to retake a test, students must do the following:

- All assignments/daily practices for that unit must be completed and turned in.
- Make corrections on the question(s) that students missed and explain what students did wrong and how students corrected the mistakes.
- Make an appointment with Mrs. Khim to retake on their own time before/after school

**\*\*\*Please keep in mind that retake grade cannot exceed a score of 3.\*\*\***

## Daily Assignment & Classwork

Students are expected to have math assignment(s) daily. These daily assignments are intended to help master skills that are learned in class. Students will be given time each day in class to work on the daily assignment which usually consists of Practice Problems sets from the textbook. If assignments are not finished in class, students must complete at home before the next school day. It is very important for students to complete their daily assignments on-time and put in their best effort.

## Materials

Students will be expected to bring the following everyday:

- Math workbook
- Progress log/notes (this will be given in class)
- Pencils
- Red/blue pens (for making corrections)
- Highlighters (3-5 colors),
- Chromebook

## Class Expectations

It is expected that students will be engaged in the process of thinking and learning math at all times. Multiple opportunities will exist, and each student is expected to contribute on a daily basis.

1. **Be Respectful:** to yourself, classmates, other adults, guest teacher(s), and Mrs. Khim.
2. **Be Responsible:** come prepared with all materials (workbook, pencil, eraser, and required materials). Take ownership of your own learning and work hard.
3. **Be Part of the Solution:** make good choices and be aware of others. Work independently and with others. Actively listen during class instruction, ask questions and help to answer the questions of your teacher or classmates.
