

FREE BREAKFAST & LUNCH FOR MOE STUDENTS

Monroe Elementary is a CEP school, which means breakfast and lunch will continue to be free for all of our Monroe Eagles. This is a four-year program, and we are entering the second year. None of our families needs to fill out a Free and Reduced Lunch form to benefit from this program.

ATTENDANCE REMINDERS

We hope to see your student at school every day, but we understand illnesses and emergencies do happen. In the event you need to report your student absent, please email MOEAttendance@everettsd.org. Please include:

- Student Name
- Student ID Number
- Teacher Name
- Date(s) of Absence
- Reason for Absence
- Parent/Guardian Name
- Parent/Guardian Phone Number

The email must be from the one we have on file for you. If we do not have an email address on file, or if you are unable to send an email, please call our Attendance Line at (425) 385-7302 and leave a message with the information mentioned above.

For extended absences due to travel, up to five days are excused, and we request that you fill out a Prearranged Absence Form so we can prepare for your child's absence. This form can be found in our office or by clicking <u>here</u>.

NEW ARRIVAL PROCEDURES

Your child's safety is of the utmost importance to us. After touring our building with our district Safety and Security Coordinator, we are changing our arrival procedures. Students may continue to be dropped off at the Drive-through Lane; however, they will now walk along the south side of our building toward the back covered area of the school. Those students eating breakfast at Monroe will enter through a side door, which leads directly to our cafeteria. First, second, and third-grade students will use this same door and then make a right into our gym to line up with their classmates. Fourth and fifth grade students not eating breakfast will walk through the gate to the covered area to their class lines. Our Kindergarten students will continue to line up in the Eagles' Nest to the left of our main entrance.

Parents/guardians walking their students to their line will say goodbye outside of the side door or gate. Any adults who will be remaining on campus will first check in at the office by using the intercom and being buzzed in at the main front doors. All campus visitors or volunteers will need to sign in and obtain a badge.

We appreciate you understanding this change in process. This new routine will keep our Eagles and adults safe in the event of an emergency since we will always know who is in our building. Please refer to the <u>Arrival and Dismissal Procedures</u> on our website for more information.
